

POST-LIQUID NITROGEN TREATMENT CARE

- It is normal for the treated area to be painful after freezing. For excessive pain, take Tylenol (acetaminophen) or NSAIDs such as ibuprofen as directed on the bottle.
- The area will be red and flaky for the next 1-2 weeks.
- A blister with clear or bloody fluid may develop. You may puncture the blister with a sterile needle if it becomes painful.
- You may wash the area normally with soap and water.
- You may apply Aquaphor or petroleum jelly (Vaseline) ointment if it becomes very flaky.
- Potential side effects of this treatment include: pain, bleeding, discoloration, scar formation, rarely infection.
- Depending on what is being treated, the area may require repeat treatment in approximately 3-4 weeks.
